- **Closing the Gap in Reading & Writing:** Join our intensive and focused program for students in need of a boost in reading and writing. Teachers are trained in the Orton-Gillingham method, a high-quality instructional approach intended primarily for students who struggle with reading, spelling, and writing.

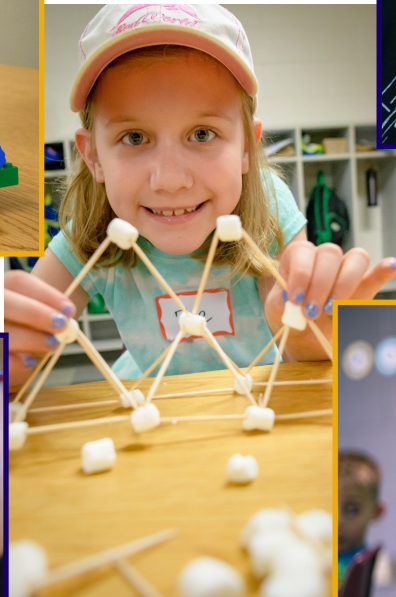
